

## The 18th International Festival of Non-commercial Film Makers Tallinn`2020

The 18th International Festival of Non-commercial Film Makers Tallinn`2020 will be held in Tallinn. The festival will be organized by the Association of Estonian Non-Commercial Cinema

All film amateurs and filmstudents will be invited to participate in the festival. The number by one author (club) is not limited.

The length of the film can be up to 20 minutes.

As the working languages of the festival are Estonian , English and German.. In case the film is in German or any other except English, the film must have English subtitles.

The films will be judged in 3 groups:

A-group – the films of young film makers (till 20 years old)

B-group - the films of filmstudents

C-group – all others amateur film makers

The Jury composes a programme of the presented films according to its pre-selection. The participants will be notified of the Jury's decision .

The programme will be shown on **28.11.2020** in the cinema Artis (Solaris Center, Estonia str. 9, Tallinn).

The opening of the festival will take place at 11 a.m. T

The Films will be awarded separately in A, B and C-groups with the 1st, 2nd, 3rd prizes and special diplomas.

Association of Estonian Non-Commercial Cinema guarantees to return the films within two months after the official closing of the festival.

The hotel rooms will be chosen, reserved and paid by the participants themselves.
